**Project Overview**

Supply Crushed Rock & Granular as per Tender document. This work shall consist of the supply of all labour, equipment, and materials to supply granular materials on the roads within the Township of Champlain. The material will be delivered and spread by belly dumps or dump trailers for bulk dumping.

1. All material shall be according to the latest version of the Ontario Provincial Standard Specifications (OPSS).
2. The gradation requirements for Granular "A" are modified as follows:
  - 100% of material supplied must pass 22.4 mm sieve.
3. The gradation requirements for the <106 mm material are as follows:
  - Material supplied to be full output from crushing operation - 100% of material must pass a <106 mm sieve. Percent passing 75 mm sieve 0-8 (10%). Material must be well graded and readily able to be compacted. If not, blending material must be supplied and blended by Contractor.
4. All natural material must be produced in a limestone quarry.
5. All material shall be produced and stockpiled as per the latest version of OPSS 1001 and OPSS.MUNI 1010.
