Purpose: Written notice of approval of by-laws passed at the October 22, 2025, Regular Meeting of Council

Under the Authority of Part VI.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the Municipal Act, 2001, (the "Act") and amendments to O. Reg. 530/22 made under the Act, I, Normand Riopel, Mayor of Champlain Township, hereby approve the following by-laws passed at the Township of Champlain Regular Council meeting of October 22, 2025, in accordance with subsection 284.11(4)(a)(i) of the Act :

- 2025-63 – Being a By-law to authorize alternate voting methods for the 2026 Municipal Elections.
- 2025-64 – Being a By-Law to authorize the renewal of the loan for the Highway 34 Reconstruction Project.
- 2025-65 – Being a By-law to authorize the renewal of the loan for the Lagoon Reconstruction Project and the Highway 34 Water and Sewer Works Project.
- 2025-66 – Being a By-law to authorize the renewal of the loan for the King Street Reconstruction Project and the L'Original Standpipe Rehabilitation Project.
- 2025-67 – Being a By-law for the purpose of setting fees and charges levied for the years 2026 to 2030.
- 2025-68 – Being a By-law for the keeping of hens in residential areas within the Township of Champlain.
- 2025-69 – Being a By-law to amend By-law 2025-45, a by-law to authorize the levying of the amount paid for the substantial completion of construction of Sections



1, 2 and 3 of the Mill Creek Municipal Drain, in the Township of Champlain, which was constructed under emergency designation of the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs in accordance with Resolution 2016-280, and By-law 2022-18
